Real Estate Education in the COVID-19 landscape – Challenges, Experiences, Opportunities

The seminar will provide a forum for the exchange of experiences and best practice in teaching and learning during the Covid-19 period, under four broad themes:

- 1.- Challenges created by Covid-19**
- 2.- Delivering the curriculum in the Covid-19 landscape**
- 3.- Integrating the real world in the Covid-19 landscape**

The seminar will combine individual presentations panels with panel debates under each of the four themes. Theme 3 will cover:

- Virtual field trips
- Enhancing commercial awareness and employability
- Embedding opportunities for personal and professional development
- Managing industry inputs
- Industry coaching/mentoring
- Graduate recruitment activities

Theme 4 will cover:

- Identifying the positives
- Contributions to pedagogic knowledge
- What are the changes to delivery modes, student engagement and assessment which will become permanent?
- The 'right' amount of technology and its effective use
- Facilitates sharing best practice with colleagues on a global basis
- Online as a threat to conventional delivery?
- A better work life balance for real estate educators?
